Group Trivia

Needed: music + one question per participant

How it works: Hand out one question per participant. Move around until the music stops, then ask your question to the participant who's closest to you.

Game duration: 3-5 rounds, with each round lasting +/- 3 minutes.

This way, each person answers 3-5 questions in total.

Questions

Which is your favorite Bible book, and why?

Who is your hero from the New Testament (not incl. Yeshua)?

Which Biblical site would you like to visit (or visit again)?

If you had to teach one Bible lesson, what topic would you choose?

In your opinion, what's the perfect place for a family vacation? Also: hotel or camping?

What can really make you angry?

What motivates you to work?

Which is your favorite Parable of Yeshua?

What is your greatest fear?

What would you change about yourself if you could

Which is the most important Parable of Yeshua?

Without meeting the characters themselves - which Biblical era would you like to visit?

What was the tastiest meal you've had recently?

When you were little, what did you want to be when you grew up?

If you could choose to do anything for a day, what would it be?

Which site in Israel is a 'must-visit'?

Which is your favorite Bible story (not incl. the New Testament)?

What is the most significant event that happened to Israel (Biblical or modern Israel)?

What would you prefer to ride during a circular, flat, comfortable trip with perfect weather: a bicycle, horse, motorcycle or car?

Jerusalem, Tel Aviv, Haifa, Capernaum, Mount Hermon, a kibbutz, or an agricultural moshav?

If you were a tour guide (anywhere in the world), which tourist site would you guide the best?

Would you prefer to win the lottery or work at your dream job that makes you happy to wake up to every morning?

With which Biblical figure (not incl. Yeshua) would you be willing to be stranded on a deserted island?

What's the best gift you've ever received?

What's the worst gift you've ever received?

Which four items would you take with you to a deserted island? (a Bible and three other items)

What's the weirdest thing you've ever eaten?

If you had a warning label, what would it say?

What's your favorite worship song?

If you could choose one famous person (still alive) to sit and have coffee with, who would it be?

Genesis, Exodus or Acts?

Matthew, Mark, Luke or John?

Besides 'Samson the Strong', who do you think is physically the strongest Biblical character?

You have to guide tourists at a Biblical site – which site would you choose?

Summer, spring, fall or winter?
